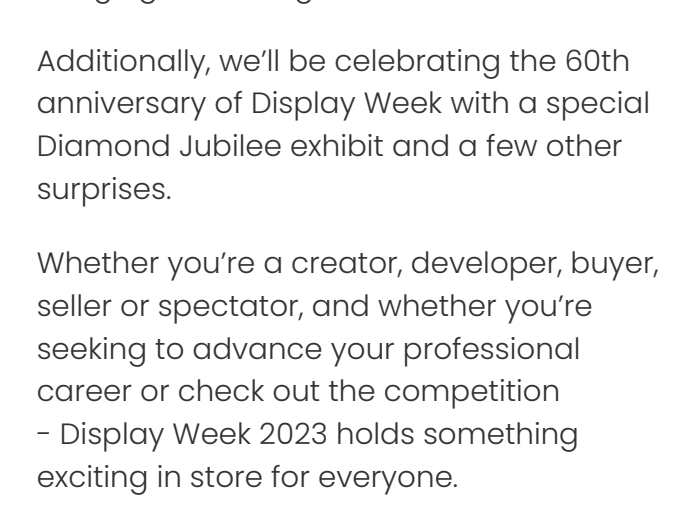




The Show of Shows Returns Home
