## Recycle Your Christmas Trees



The holidays are just around the corner. The City's Public Works Department is already making plans to recycle Christmas trees. Single-family and duplex residents will be able to place Christmas trees next to trash barrels for convenient backyard pickup. Please remove all tree decorations and tree stands, and shake off flocked trees for recycling.

All apartment and condominium residents may place trees on the parkway near the curb for pickup by Athens Services. Trees will be picked up on January 5 and 6, 2004, and will be chipped and disposed of as green waste.

By recycling your Christmas trees through Athens Services, you will be contributing to environmentally sound recycling efforts. All residents will receive a mailer with additional information in mid-December. For more information, please contact the Public Works Department at (626) 403-7240.

## Protect Your Identity During The Holidays



The Department of Justice produced a 23-minute video describing the many ways in which thieves can obtain your personal finance information, how to protect yourself from being victimized, and what to do if you are. This video is available in the South Pasadena Public Library.

The South Pasadena Police Department wants to remind everyone during the holiday season that identity theft is the fastest-growing crime in America, affecting half a million new victims each year. During the holidays, your chances of becoming a victim greatly increase. Here are some helpful tips in combating identity theft:

- Do not give out personal information over the phone, through the mail or over the Internet unless you have initiated the contact or know whom you're dealing with.
- Shred all documents, including pre-approved credit applications received in your name, insurance forms, bank checks and statements you are discarding, and other financial information.
- Do not put your telephone number on checks.
- Do not use your home's mailbox for outgoing mail. Mail should be placed in a U.S. Postal Mailbox or dropped off at the Post Office itself.
- Be careful using ATMs and phone cards. Someone may look over your shoulder and get your PIN numbers, thereby gaining access to your accounts.
- Make a list of all your credit card account numbers and bank account numbers with customer service phone numbers and keep it in a safe place.
- Do not put your credit card number on the Internet unless it is encrypted on a secured site.
- Cancel all credit cards that you have not used in the last six months. Open credit is a prime target.

By following the simple rules above, your chances of becoming the next victim of identity theft greatly decreases. For more information on how you can combat identity theft, please call the South Pasadena Police Department at (626) 403-7270.

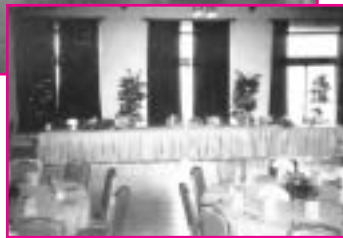
## STREET IMPROVEMENTS UPDATE

Specific Local Street Repairs	Repairs have recently been completed on Illinois Drive, Hillside Road and Hermosa Street. Improvements for Garfield Avenue, St. Albans, Oak Hill Avenue and Glendon Way are currently being designed.
Orange Grove Striping	Temporary striping modifications are scheduled to be installed on Orange Grove Avenue north of the 110 Freeway. The temporary striping will be in place for a minimum of 60 days, after which the City will evaluate its effectiveness for future design considerations on Orange Grove Avenue.
Access Ramp Project	Wheelchair access ramps are scheduled to be constructed at various locations throughout the City beginning in early spring 2004. Tentative locations include Fremont Avenue, Oak Street and Garfield Avenue.
Fair Oaks Improvements	Design for improvements to Fair Oaks Avenue and the 110 Freeway on-ramp are underway.

Wilson Well No. 2	Preliminary well investigations began in September to determine the possibility of bringing the well back into service.
Grand Reservoir and Pumping Station	The environmental review and final design drawings are expected to be completed this winter.

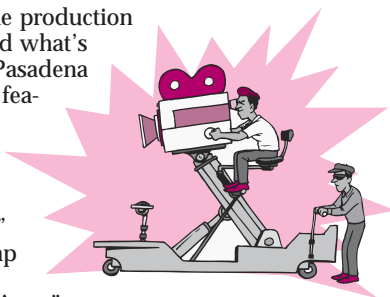


## Scene Around Town

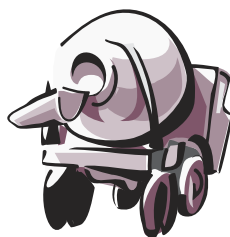
## Mission Meridian Village Project Updates

The Mission Meridian Village project is moving along right on schedule. Concrete pouring has begun on the public parking garage and on the south end of the mixed-use project. To accommodate the Mission Street merchants and neighbors during the Christmas holidays, the contractor has changed the concrete-placement schedule so no concrete pumping will occur from December 2 to January 6. Significant concrete pouring will take place on January 14 and January 19.

Power and communication utilities will be installed underground from Hope Street northward to Magnolia Street, westward along Magnolia, and southward on Santa Fe Lane to Mission Street. The removal of the unsightly overhead utility lines will greatly enhance the aesthetics and charm of the neighborhood.

The project will include 67 new condominiums in two courtyard-type buildings designed in Craftsman style and 5,000 square feet of retail shops and lofts in a brick boulevard building along Meridian Avenue. One level of public parking (142 spaces) is available for Gold Line commuters. The project will be complete in spring 2004.

# Programs Help Lower Utility Bills

Southern California Edison offers a number of programs designed to assist low-income and senior residents to lower their electricity bills.

- The California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE) program gives a 20-percent discount on electricity bills for low-income households. Residents who are accepted in the program also receive a 20-percent discount on their gas bill, courtesy of the Southern California Gas Company. Please contact (800) 447-6620 for more information.
- The Medical Baseline Allocation Program reduces electricity bills to residents dependent on electrically powered life support or mobility equipment. To learn more, call (800) 655-4555.
- The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) provides eligible households assistance to offset the costs of heating or cooling their home. Please call (800) 339-6993 for more information.
- The Energy Assistance Fund (EAF) provides assistance to income-qualified, elderly or disabled residential customers facing temporary financial difficulties on their winter electric bill. Please call (800) 655-4555.

# Placing Your Trash Containers Out Properly Can Facilitate Pickup

Trash collection service for the City of South Pasadena is provided by Athens Services, the City's authorized collection agency. The basic service is for household refuse collected once per week from the backyard of your property. The amount of refuse is limited to one cubic yard or 220 gallons, not to exceed 65 pounds per container. This is equivalent to about six 35-gallon-size standard trash containers. Of these six containers, any number you wish may be labeled for yard-waste collection. Yard waste consists of grass clippings, leaves and tree trimmings. Yard waste will only be collected when it is placed in properly labeled, designated yard-waste containers. Yard-waste stickers are available at City Hall, or by calling the Public Works Department at (626) 403-7240.

Please follow these simple guidelines for proper placement of trash containers:

- First, find one location for all containers in your backyard. The backyard location must be on the driveway side of the house, by the side of the house or garage, or in the backyard through an access gate (make sure pets are contained). Trash containers are not to be located at the curb.
- When choosing your backyard location, keep in mind that trash containers cannot be carried up or down stairs or lifted over fences.
- Providing free and clear access to your trash containers is essential to good service. If a car is parked in the driveway on trash day, for example, the disposal company would have to return and additional charges would apply.
- Finally, containers must be located within 10 feet to which the collection vehicle can drive.
